The proprietor Rt. Reverend Olugbenga Olukemi Oduntan received a vision to start a school within Idi-Igba/Abojupa Scheme area in February 1997. The school did not take off until 21st day of April 1997 with two pupils whose parents have been earnestly praying and expecting a school whether government or private school around Idi-Igba and Eleekara.

The school took off in an uncompleted building used as a church by St. Stephen's Anglican Church Eleekara. The building was owned by Mr. Ibikunle.

Miss Olatundun Olawale was a certified Grade II and NCE holder who was employed to teach the children with the proprietress Mrs. Felicia Mayokun Oduntan who had to resign her P.T.A teaching at Olivet Baptist High School where she was teaching English Language.

This prospectus is aimed at giving you an overview of the schools. We hope you will support our vision to make your child a world shaker. It is our believe that parental involvement enhances learning and parental co-operation is highly solicited so as to get the best for our children since parents are the best teachers.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

In furtherance of the Lord's Kiddies vision, Lord's, Lord's Secondary School took off on the 18th of September 2006 with nine pioneering students, seven of them in JSS one and two in JSS two.

Six teachers were recruited as pioneer staff primary school building was used as the temporary classroom and staff rooms while construction work on the secondary school building was in progress.

Lord's Secondary School on the other hand started on the note that the government specified then that what was recognised was 9-3-4. It was emphasised that we should train students till at least Junior Secondary School three. That motivated us to start Junior Secondary School on the 18th of September 2006 with nine pioneering students, seven of them in JSS1 and two in JSS2.

Mr. S.A. Olatunji was the pioneer principal. Six teachers were employed as the pioneer teachers.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The schools run a unified and concurrent calendar with the stipulations and dictates of the Ministry of Education. An academic session begins in September and closes in July all things being equal. All holidays and breaks approved by the Ministry of Education or declared by the government are

duly observed by the school. School opens from 7:30am to 12noon for nursery and 3:00pm primary to Basic 9 by while till 4pm for SSS1-3. We close by 2:00pm on Friday and 4pm respectively for upper secondary school.

International curricula also are being observed whereby we catered for all students in teaching and learning, that is Blended curriculum Those who are interested in writing international examination do so on international schedule time table.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The schools offer admission for children that can walk till SS2. The school is a mixed school both males and female are welcome. The school is a Christian mission school but the studentship is opened to both Christians and non-Christians provided the students and parents comply with the ethics and code of conducts of the school.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- (1) The child must collect an application form, filled and returned to the school.
- (2) Child would be tested (oral/written) as the case may be to determine his/her level of education attainment.
- (3) It is necessary for the child to pass the interview.
- (4) The child must be healthy and all information regarding to the school must be given by the parents. Parents should not hide the health status of the child.
- (5) Pupils must be well and neatly dressed.
- (6) Pupils are advised to buy two pairs of uniform to enhance neatness.
- (7) Lateness is forbidden. All pupils must report at school latest by 7:30am.
- (8) The school shall not condone indiscipline where there is need to apply rod, it shall not be spared.
- (9) The pupils are expected to bring their writing materials to school at resumption- pen, pencil, eraser, wax crayon, sharpener, note books and textbooks.

- (11) A photocopy of the child's birth certificate must be attached with the registration form and a file at submission.
